

## **BPB HOA Waste Guidelines**

### **RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE PICK-UP**

#### Setout Info

Garbage is collected twice per week, recycling and yard waste are picked up only once per week, and bulk trash is collected once monthly.

**<u>Trash (Black)</u>**: Mondays and Thursdays

Loose Recycle (Blue) & Yard Waste (Green): Thursday only

**Bulk Pickup:** FOURTH Monday only

# **Citywide Guidelines**

- Place your carts roadside before 7 am on your pickup day, but no earlier than 6 pm the evening prior to your scheduled collection.
- The lids on all carts must be able to close completely.
- When placing carts roadside, make sure the handles face the sidewalk and the lid openings face the street. Place on the blacktop **IN** the roadway, not on the sidewalk!
- Place carts and Bulk Trash piles at least 1 foot apart and away from parked cars.
- It is prohibited to block any driveway with the carts.
- All carts must be removed from the roadside and secured on your property *out of street view* the same pickup day, Monday or Thursday.

## **Our Guidelines**

- 1. All bins need to be clearly labeled with the house numbers, minimum of the last two digits.
- 2. Bins should be set out on the south side of the street after 6 pm on Sunday or Wednesday night.
- 3. All bins should be collected on the day of service before dusk.
- 4. Bins should not be broken or damaged. Call 954-828-8000 if you need a replacement.
- 5. It is recommended that bins are cleaned routinely.
- 6. If trash or recycling falls out of bins due to overstuffing or weather, residents who own them are responsible for collecting the debris blown or spilled from the bin.
- 7. NO BAGS are allowed in the Blue Recycling dumpster. All items are to be loose for the sorting machine. Your rates have been increasing due to bagged items being discarded.
- 8. Bins are not to be stored on the street or sidewalk, and should be stored out of sight.
- 9. For Bulk Trash pickups: your green landscape bulk needs to be in a separate pile away from the other trash pile. Piles go in the road as if parking a small car.
